**Determinate** -- Also called "bush" tomatoes. Grow to a compact height (approximately 4 feet). Stop growing when fruit sets on the top bud. Ripen all their crop at or near the same time (usually over a 2-week period). Limited amount of caging and/or staking required. Should NOT be pruned or "suckered" as it severely reduces the crop. Perform well in a container (5-6 gallon size).

**Indeterminate** -- Also called "vining" tomatoes. Grow and produce fruit until killed by frost. Can reach heights of 6-10 feet (6 feet are the norm). Blooms, sets new fruit and ripens fruit all at the same time throughout the growing season. Substantial caging and/or staking required. Pruning and the removal of suckers is practiced by many, but not mandatory.

**Open-Pollination** -- When pollination occurs by insect, bird, wind, humans or other natural mechanisms. Because there are no restrictions on the flow of pollen between individuals, open-pollinated plants are more genetically diverse. This can cause a greater amount of variation within plant populations, which allows plants to slowly adapt to local growing conditions and climate year-to-year. As long as pollen is not shared between different varieties within the same species, then the seed produced will remain true-to-type year after year.

**Heirloom** -- A plant variety that has been passed down, through several generations of a family because of its valued characteristics. An heirloom variety must be open-pollinated, but not all open-pollinated plants are heirloom varieties. Every heirloom variety is genetically unique. Inherent in this uniqueness is an evolved resistance to pests and diseases and an adaptation to specific growing conditions and climates.

**Heirloom Marriage** -- Hybrid varieties that are produced from modern day unions of heirloom parents, providing hybrid vigor while maintaining the virtue and integrity of their old-fashioned beginnings. They were bred for improved yield, earlier maturity and fewer blemishes while maintaining old-time flavor. By crossing two beloved heirlooms together, the resulting cultivar bears the best qualities of both parent varieties with the added benefits of hybrid vigor, disease resistance, uniformity and yield.
